

FLC Tuition Chart 2024-25

*FLC requires a **\$400 non-refundable deposit per household due on July 15**. For families enrolling after July 15, we ask for the deposit at the time of enrollment

***Monthly tuition is from September 2024-June 2025**. To ensure stability for the program and guides, *you are expected to commit to an entire year of tuition at the time of enrollment.*

***Tuition is due on the first of the month** and can be paid via Venmo (@ForestLearningCollective), check, or cash.
